



NATIONAL SEMINARS

DISTINGUISHED STALWARTS DISSEMINATING THE PEARLS OF WISDOM

With a view to expand the information vistas and drink deep from the reservoirs of knowledge, National Seminars were organized in the Departments of English, Punjabi, Commerce and Sciences. The sessions were presided over by academicians of repute and distinction.

"Diasporic Indian English Literature: Issues and Concerns"

The Post Graduate Department of English organized National Seminar on "Diasporic Indian English Literature: Issues and Concerns". Dr. Rajesh Sharma, Professor, Department of English, Punjabi University, Patiala was the chairperson and Dr. Shivani Thakar, Department of Distance Education, Punjabi University Patiala was the chief guest on the occasion. As many as 114 delegates participated in the conference.

POST GRADUATE DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

Deliberating on participation in seminars, Dr. Rajesh Sharma stated that a researcher writes paper and reads it in order to

enhance his understanding of the subject, which is necessary for a litterateur. He termed Diaspora as a cultivated literature and expressed concern over a large chunk of literature, both poetry and nonfiction which needs to be explored. Quoting examples from writers such as, Sandeep Parmar, Kiran Kapur, Atul Gawande, Siddharth Mukherjee, Amit Chaudhary and many more, he explained that diasporic identity is a challenge in itself, which should be optimally utilized and creatively experienced.

Dr. H.S.Arora read Dr. Bhim Singh Dahiya's inaugural address in his absentia. Dr. Bhim Singh Dahiya is the former Vice Chancellor of Kurukshetra University. Due to his ill health, he could not attend the seminar. Talking on the writings of Diasporic writers, he stated "a literary writer's driving force is imagination and not facts." A writer should not be judged by the authenticity of historical facts, but by the creation of his characters, situations and speculations. He concluded by saying that decidedly diasporic Indian writers have given a significant turn to the Indian English Writing. Interesting observations were made by Dr. Shivani Thakar.

The Guest of Honour Sh. G.S.Brar in all his humility stated that being a student of science, this seminar has indeed added to his knowledge on GST. He made a plea to all present to bring into practice e-transaction system, which has numerous advantages and this practice needs to be disseminated amongst common people also. The technical sessions were chaired by Dr. Ashish Arora, Prof. Amit Jain, Prof. Rajiv Puri and Dr. Puneet Pathak.

In the valedictory session, Dr. Puneet Pathak made observations on the papers presented. Dr. Ashish Arora in his valedictory address stated that GST is truly the beacon which has brought an instrumental change in tax collection and converted unorganized sector into organized sector. He advised the students on how to carry out empirical research at a micro level on the given topic.

"Emerging Scenario In Basic and Applied Sciences For Sustainable Development"

National Seminar on "Emerging Scenario In Basic and Applied Sciences For Sustainable Development" was jointly organised by the Departments of Chemistry, Physics, Botany and Zoology. The keynote speaker on the occasion was Dr. R.K. Kohli, Vice Chancellor, Central University of Punjab. Dr. Rajesh Kumar (HoD, Centre for Chemical Sciences, Central University of Punjab), Dr. Sanjeev Thakur (Centre for Plant Sciences, Central University of Punjab), Dr. Navdeep Shekhar (HoD, Botany, Akal University, Talwandi Sabo), Dr. Rohit Mehra (Department of Physics, NIT Jalandhar) were the resource persons on the occasion. 45 oral presentations, 49 poster presentations in three technical sessions viz. Chemistry, Physics and Biology were made. Dr. R.K.Kohli stated that in order to transform from a developing to a developed nation we should frame long term planning. He also spoke on topics like Deforestation, Bio-Diversity Loss, Ecological Imbalance and Neuro Studies.

Dr. Sanjay Sharma chaired the technical session of Chemistry. He spoke about the utilization of MOF platform for Stecker Synthesis for Amino Nitriles, and explained about Protein Assembly, Protein Creation, Iron Release, Radioactive Release and many other current topics.

Dr. Rohit Mehra was the Resource Person for technical session of Physics. He explained about uranium and heavy matter pollution in Ground water. He further stated that uranium contamination in drinking water in the Malwa belt of Punjab is within the safe limit according to WHO. He also said that research should be innovative and have some social impact.

Dr. Navdeep Shekhar and Dr. Sanjeev Thakur chaired the session for Botany. Dr. Navdeep Shekhar gave lecture on Synthetic life, fact or fantasy. He mentioned various aspects of synthetic life and defined life as DNA Software system.

Dr. Sanjeev Thakur spoke about new areas in science and research. He also said how heavy metals make their way into food stuffs, climate change and population explosion.

In the valedictory session, Dr. Rajeev Sharma, Dean Physical Sciences, Modi College Patiala spoke at length on environment conservation. Certificates were also distributed by the guests to the participants in the valedictory session.

- A declamation programme was organized to highlight the social evils existing in our society.












STUDENT WELFARE DEPARTMENT


