- A declamation programme was organized to highlight the social evils existing in our society.








STUDENT WELFARE DEPARTMENT






- The PG Department of Commerce and Management organized 2nd Annual Quiz Competition.







- The endowed students left an indelible impression on the minds of the audience in "Le






