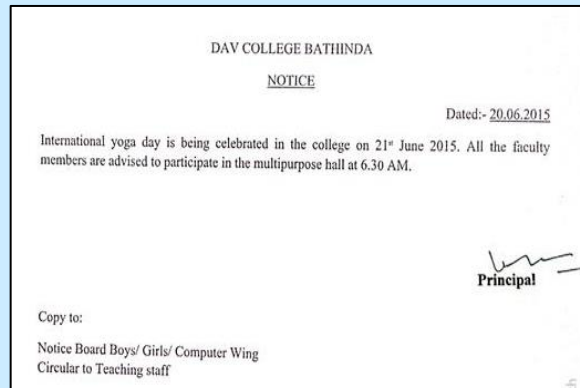
National Science Day

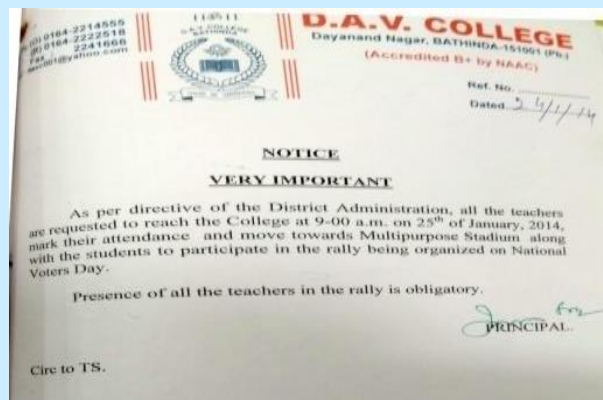
International Yoga Day
