



Dr Johl said that agrarian crisis is an emotive issue and a conference organized is a step taken in the direction of expressing anguish and exchanging views to address the problem. He stated that agriculture being Punjab's lifeline needs to be revived and emphasized on the need of the adoption of China's and Japan's agricultural model as one of the solutions to the problem. He called upon the governments to stand by the farmers in this hour of extreme adversity and distress and come to their rescue. Dwelling on the issue , education, he said is another frontier which is a birthright of every child irrespective of his class, caste or creed and by educating the youth of our country we can sensitise them towards these problems. On this occasion Dr. Sardara Singh Johl also released a book titled "Jasveer Mandke novel aud de beej kaup bhashaiadyan" authored by Prof. Ravi Nagpal, Assistant Professor, Department of Punjabi.

The chief guest for the Valedictory function was Dr. Sucha Singh Gill, Professor, CRRID, Chandigarh. Reflecting on the problem, he said that farmers' problem is not only an economic crisis, but a social crisis too and Punjab needs to find a solution on its own. He spoke on a farmer's life which is beset with various problems like illiteracy, unemployment, low wages, mounting debts which all lead towards the poor farmers committing suicides. A ray of hope could be seen as this aggravated problem of the farmers is even finding expression in various other disciplines like literature. He suggested pooling of the resources through cooperative farming and the marketing of their produce by the farmers as well.

• Rover Rajat Garg is the proud recipient of the highest President Award, bestowed upon the Scouts, Guides, Rovers, Rangers and Scouts Masters. This award was presented by His Excellency the Hon'ble President of India Dr. Pranab Mukherjee in the President House. Scout Rajat Garg was nominated by the Head Office, New Delhi for this award on the successful completion of his three years syllabus and on passing the physical test.

• Pushpinder Singh (BA III Year) Senior Under Officer (SUO) of NCC, as a part of DGNCC Mountaineering Expedition 2016, scaled the Mt Bagirathi-II (Uttarakhand) 6512 M/ 21365 ft, sixth highest peak in India. He had earlier fetched laurels to the institution by climbing Mt. Kanchunjunga in the year 2015, the second highest peak in the world. On his return journey, he was honoured by the Chief of Indian Army in Delhi.





• Arshpreet Kaur's [MA Political Science I] exemplary feats in Horse Riding have won her many prestigious awards by the highest chairs in India. Arshpreet Kaur has been the first girl to participate as the "Prime Minister Rally Commander" at New Delhi in 2014 and win an unprecedented Gold in 2014 and 2015 for the same. In 2014 she won a silver and bronze in "Darsage Competition" and "Hacks Competition" respectively. The year 2015 once again saw this roaring rider win a gold and silver in "Show Jumping Competition" at New Delhi. Her exceptional valour catapulted her to win the Best Rider Trophy in Show Jumping Competition at New Delhi. Making her home Punjab bask in the warmth of glory, she made Punjab regain its first position after a gap of 38 years by setting a new record of crossing 1/65 metre height in

"Six Bar Competition" and winning eight Gold Medals in state level competitions. Her extraordinary triumphs have made her name register in the Horse Riding Book.
