

Action taken Report

(2021-22)

The college constantly works towards providing the best in the field of academics, sports, extra-curricular and infrastructure. For this purpose, the feedback mechanism is used to its best advantage and the suggestions provided by the benefactors, i.e. parents, employers, alumni, teachers and students are incorporated.

Alumni feedback

Interaction with the senior students helps the college students to draw inspiration from their lives. On the feedback provided by the bright alumni, following measures have been taken:

- i) Alumni Meet of those serving as school teachers was organised. This provided a constructive platform to the students, alumni, faculty as well as the administration interact in an informal way.
- ii) Motivational lectures and talks by the alumni are also organised which play a crucial role. On the suggestion of the alumni, students are also taken on field visits, besides those prescribed in the curriculum.
- iii) AQAR of the academic session 2020-21 has been submitted to NAAC and is available on the website for the stakeholders to review.

Employers' Feedback

Paying heed to the managements of various organisations following measures have been taken for the benefit of the students:

- i) The Competitive Examination Cell prepares students for the competitive exams which make them aware of the various career options available after graduation/post graduation and equips them with better job opportunities. To achieve this objective a proper class schedule is formulated, wherein the lectures are delivered by competent faculty, printed notes are provided and meticulously designed test series are made available to the students. Students are also informed about the entry process, the course curriculum of their preferred choices, structure of examinations and the advertisements.
- ii) Soft skills development classes are also organised which prepare the students to face interviews and polish their skills, thus making them self-confident.
- iii) To improve the quality of science education and providing a blend of practical based teaching and learning, the College has been awarded with the "Star College Scheme" by the Department of Biotechnology (D.B.T.), under the Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India scheme. Under this scheme, a grant of Rs. 44 Lacs has been sanctioned to the departments of Physics and Chemistry.
- iv) DST- SERB sponsored national conference on "Recent Advances in Sciences for Sustainable Development" was organised by the Departments of Physics and

- Chemistry. (March 5, 2022) A grant of Rs. 50,000/- has been received in college from SERB.
- v) SERB sponsored national conference on “Computational Techniques and Mathematical Modeling” was organised by the Department of Computer Science and the Department of Mathematics. (March 12, 2022).Rs.75, 000/- has been received in college from DST-SERB.
 - vi) National Science Day was celebrated on the theme “Integrated Approach in Science & Technology for Sustainable Future” sponsored by Punjab State Council for Science and Technology, NCSTC and DST.
 - vii) Innovation Hub, under the DBT-STAR College scheme, with 25 interesting experiments has also been set up at the Department of Physics. All the experiments have been designed with an aim to inculcate greater interest in practical physics and to make it easier for students to grasp various important concepts.
 - viii) Educational trips and industrial visits are organised for providing hands-on knowledge to the students.
 - ix) Webinars, Workshops and Online Capacity Building Programmes are organised at regular intervals to enhance the trajectories of students’ knowledge.
 - x) To make students responsible citizens and making them aware of the contribution of many which has led to the progress of the nation, various days, like, Vigilance Awareness Day, World Aids Day, Voters Day, Independence Day, National Mathematics Day, International Matribhasha Diwas, etc. are celebrated in the college.
 - xi) To teach students the concept of selfless service towards the society, they are encouraged to participate in NSS and NCC camps.

Students’ Feedback

Students have expressed satisfaction with the overall atmosphere of the college. In response to the students’ feedback, few initiatives taken by the college are:

- i) Fee payment through online mode has been facilitated. For this purpose the college has entered into collaboration with Axis Bank. Fee can now be paid via UPI, PhonePe, Paytm, GPay, QRcode, etc.
- ii) Monthly Assignments are being given to the students which help in the revision of the syllabus completed. Class tests are also made compulsory.
- iii) 400 mt. running track and basketball court have been constructed to provide students a recreational time after their class schedules.
- iv) Cricket Academy has been started and two coaches have been appointed. Lights too have been installed on the cricket practice pitch.
- v) Many academic and co-curricular events are also organised at regular intervals for the holistic development of the students.

- vii) Athletic Meet was organised for the physical development of the students.
- viii) Various industrial visits were organised by the Career Counselling and Placement Cell.

On the basis of the feedback and responses collected by the faculty, following steps have been taken:

- i) In order to help them enhance their knowledge, faculty members and students have been provided with Login IDs and Passwords for accessing E-Resources through N-LIST programme.
- ii) To add to their knowledge reservoirs, the college administration encourages the faculty to attend workshops, FDPs, Orientation Programmes, Refresher Courses, Short term courses sponsored by UGC and other government organisations. To support this, they are sanctioned duty leaves.
