# DAV COLLEGE BATHINDA'S SCIENTIST OBSERVES HIGH LEVELS OF FLUORIDE IN MALWA'S GROUNDWATER

Dr. Vikas Duggal (Department of Physics) of DAV College Bathinda conducted a

study on Fluoride contamination in drinking water and associated

health risk assessment in the Malwa belt of Punjab, India,

published in Environmental Advances (Elsevier) Journal. Dr.

Duggal stated that the previous studies showhigh levels of

Uranium, Arsenic, Lead, Cadmium, and other heavy metals

in the groundwater of the Malwa region, Punjab. On

studying 745 ground water samplesfrom seven districts

(Bathinda, Mansa, Faridkot, Muktsar, Fazilka, Barnala, and

Moga) of the Malwa region revealed that groundwater has

high concentrations of fluoride. The fluoride concentrations in

groundwater samples from the Bathinda, Mansa, Faridkot, Muktsar,

Fazilka, Barnala, and Moga districts, exceeded the permissible limit as

recommended by the Bureau of Indian Standards and World Health Organization. High fluoride levels were observed in shallow groundwater sources up to a depth of 30 meters. The non-carcinogenic risk of fluoride was calculated for various age groups and it was observed that children and teenagers are more vulnerable to high fluoride exposure than adults, senior citizens, and infants. High risks of dental and skeletal fluorosis for all age groups in the Bathinda, Mansa, Faridkot, and Muktsar districts also came into notice. It has thus been inferred that the groundwater of the Bathinda, Mansa, Faridkot, and Muktsar districts may pose serious health risks to the population if consumed for longer periods without prior treatment.

Dr. Vikas Duggal thanked the college and the Department of Physics profusely for providing necessary support to carry this research work. He stated that under the aegis of DBT Star College Scheme, he alongwith the undergraduate students of Sciences will further investigate the fluoride content in other drinking water sources such as canal water, municipal reverse osmosis water, domestic water supply, and bottled water.

The Principal Dr. Rajeev Kumar Sharma congratulated and applauded the efforts of Dr. Vikas Duggal in conducting a research of immediate concern for the residents of Malwa region. He stated that this research is recommended as it would educate the community on dangers of using groundwater with excess of fluoride.


